Free parking

During daily setup and dismantling times: trade fair grounds* Outside of daily setup and dismantling times: truck pool

* The deposit certificate can be requested at check-in. After loading and offloading have been completed at the hall courtyards, you'll receive a parking authorisation stamp for your deposit voucher at the transition from the hall courtyards to the grounds (P30, P31, P32).

Parking vehicles/trailers at the truck pool is not permitted on trade fair days. Please contact the central security office by phone with any questions concerning parking during the trade fair, or if you're interested in RV parking spaces. Vehicle Access Rules at a Glance

The trade fair grounds can be accessed by vehicles via gate 2 and check-in at the truck pool. Follow the "Anlieferung" signs when approaching the trade fair grounds.

Vehicles may only remain on the trade fair grounds for a limited period of time:

Trade Fair **

Setup and Dismantling	During the ⁻
Cars: 1 hour	0.5 hours
Cars with trailers / small vans: 2 hours	0.5 hours
Trucks: 3 hours	0.5 hours

Access is only possible from 7 a.m. to 12 a.m on the last day of the trade fair.

An access deposit of €100.00 applies on all booth setup and exhibition days.

The deposit must be made in **cash** at truck pool check-in before entering the trade fair grounds, and is refunded at gate 1 upon leaving the trade fair grounds on time.

The deposit is forfeited if the time limit is exceeded.

Please contact on-site security personnel or the central security office by phone if you need additional time. Vehicles are not permitted to access the trade fair grounds on the last day of the trade fair from 12 noon until the event closes.

Access on Friday 7. Oct. 2022: Cars: as of approx. 6 p.m. - with deposit Trucks: as of approx. 7 p.m. - with deposit

After registering at check-in, dismantling vehicles will be dispatched in accordance with momentary capacity on the trade fair grounds.

Small exhibitor vehicles parked on the exhibitor parking lots of the trade fair grounds (P30, P31, P32) will be dispatched directly from there to the respective hall courtyards.
